- Students in grades Kindergarten through Sixth grade finished their MAP benchmark testing last week. Students took tests in the areas of reading, math and language usage. Teachers have received their class performance reports and have begun analyzing this data. Our students will take their individual student reports home in their Monday Folders on Monday, September 25<sup>th</sup>.
- Our kindergarten students have all completed their state required Brigance testing. For the second year, the students tested with their kindergarten teacher. We also tested later in the state mandated window. Mrs. Howell will work to get all of the information into the database before the deadline.
