
Applicable Statute or Regulation: Board Policy 01.11 General Powers and Duties of the Board of Education

Entertainment Contract Between Sound Specialist Entertainment and Client

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- 1) This Agreement is considered binding to both parties only when returned signed, with stated retainer and accepted by Sound Specialist Entertainment.
- 2) A \$800 retainer is due with submission of this agreement. Balances due must be paid in full by cash, check, or money order on or before the actual event date. Should the balance become overdue, the Client will be subject to a (\$50) service fee. A \$35 fee will be charged for each returned check. Should collection become necessary, the Client shall be responsible for all associated fees, including-but not limited to-collection agency fees, court costs and attorneys fees, in addition to the original sum agreed upon.
- 3) Client agrees to furnish Sound Specialist with safe and appropriate working conditions. This includes but is not limited to: providing a level, stable surface 20-35 feet wide by 16-24 feet deep, making arrangements with banquet facility for one 6 or 8 foot banquet table located near two functional 115 volt 20 amp outlets on separate breakers. Some lighting, video & sound packages require 4-6 115 volt 20 amp outlets on separate breakers. If these power requirements are not met, Sound Specialist cannot and will not be liable for contracted lighting, video and or sound not being used. Initial Here _____.
- 4) This agreement is subject to proven detention by Acts of God, accidents or any other conditions beyond the legitimate control of either party. Client agrees to hold Sound Specialist Entertainment harmless as much as the law in the state of Kentucky will allow.
- 5) In the event of malicious behavior or circumstances deemed by Sound Specialist Entertainment to present or imply a threat of damage to Sound Specialist equipment or staff, Sound Specialist Entertainment reserves the right to cease operations at the event. Client will be responsible for payment in full. Sound Specialist allows ample time, not to exceed 10 minutes, to resolve the situation for operations to resume. Client is responsible for providing security and controlling guests and all other persons on the premises-this is not a function of Sound Specialist.
- 6) Cancellation by Client will occur only if received in writing at least 90 days prior to the scheduled performance date; otherwise full balance will remain due. In the event of Client cancellation, Sound Specialist Entertainment shall retain an amount equal to the retainer as liquidated damages.
- 7) Sound Specialist Entertainment personnel are independent contractors and not an employee of the Client.
- 8) I have read and accept the terms of this agreement. I understand that this is the entire agreement and any modifications must be in writing and signed by both the Client and Sound Specialist Entertainment.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA)
FOR FLOYD COUNTY SCHOOLS PARTICIPATION IN THE
2017-2018 GET ONLINE AND LEARN (GOAL)
DRIVEN BY KENTUCKY POWER GRANT

This agreement is made between the Kentucky Educational Development Corporation (KEDC), 904 Rose Road, Ashland, KY 41102, and the Floyd County Board of Education, 106 North Front Avenue, Prestonsburg, KY 41653.

Purpose, Terms and Period of Contract:

1. KEDC, an educational cooperative organized under the Kentucky Interlocal Cooperation Act, having secured a grant from the American Electric Power Foundation in the amount of \$500,000 to provide virtual learning experiences for the 2017-2018 school year agrees to provide the following services to Floyd County located in the Kentucky Power service area:
 - a. Training and support for two district chosen Virtual Technology Facilitators from each high school within in the district;
 - b. A stipend for each participant in the amount of \$1,500 paid quarterly;
 - c. Support and access to virtual educational experience providers such as the Center for Interactive Learning (CILC) and the Global Nomads Group (GNG); and
 - d. Support and access to specific services related the work (technology hardware, online services, and professional development).
2. Floyd County agrees to:
 - a. Allow Virtual Technology Facilitators to attend trainings at the KEDC Ashland location on the following dates:
 - i. October 20, 2017
 - ii. November 13, 2017
 - iii. December 15, 2017
 - iv. March 5, 2018
 - a. Support Virtual Technology Facilitators in fulfilling grant responsibilities including providing substitute teachers as necessary.
 - b. Support sharing of learning with other staff.
 - c. Allow high school students to participate in virtual learning experiences under the supervision of Virtual Technology Facilitators;
 - d. Submit surveys or other related documents to show measurable growth; and
 - e. Support the work of the work of the grant by assisting KEDC and Kentucky Power in promoting how the grant has impacted learning in your district.
