The seniors would like to go on a senior trip to Chicago. The rough draft of the itinerary is attached. The rough draft cost (without adding or taking away events) is \$519 per student. The main chaperones would be Ms. Sink, Ms Webster and needing two male chaperones (Mr. Reed and Mr. Trenkamp if available and willing). We will allow parents to chaperone at the same price as the students. The students are going to fundraise individually and as a class to help pay the costs. The individual fundraisers include selling candy bars, little caesar kits, beef jerky and possibly others. The individual fundraisers will go towards their individual cost of the trip to make it more affordable. The group fundraisers such as movie night, boo grams etc will help go towards the overall cost of the senior trip. For example, if we make \$4000 on the group fundraising we can help pay the cost of \$100 per student (after all the costs of graduation and gala have been paid for).
