



### Special Education/504

- We have had an increase in our special education population from transfers in. Dec 1 count was up last year and and we've had several new students at the high school.
- Seeking Approval for addition of a special education teacher at DHS (Emotional Behavior Disorders) to be placed in DaytonA to Co-Teach with Mr. Montgomery.
  - O Seven students with IEPs mostly related to behavior are currently being serviced in DaytonA. This increased has been due to revisions or new enrollments from other schools; this addition of a teacher is warranted in order to meet the obligations that are written into those IEP's. Mr. Montgomery has assumed m to a lot of responsibility for these students and Ms. Lukens is going in there one bell every day. However, we have gotten to a point that the needs exceed those current resources.

#### **Medicaid Billing System**

- For our students who qualify for special education, are Medicaid eligible, and parent gives us permission to bill we should be recouping almost 100% of costs for the following services;
  - o Speech Therapy
  - Occupational Therapy
  - o Mental Health Therapy
  - o Physical Therapy
  - o Some evaluations
  - o Special Transportation (on days related services are provided)
  - o Health Aide and Nursing Services (toileting, feedings, medication administration, etc.)



\*Check on both RMS and Direct Billing to do a cost settlement in March/July and is paid out in one lump sum. \*\*Also do Special Transportation
