

## **Field Trip Requests:**

### **Scott High School- Volleyball- QUALIFYING EVENT\*\*\***

Scott requests permission for 23 students to travel to Valleyview High School in Louisville, KY November 3-4, 2017 to compete in the State Volleyball Tournament. Supervision was provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:3. Transportation was via district bus. Lodging was in Crowne Plaza Hotel. Meals were at hotel, event venue, and Spaghetti Warehouse in Louisville. There is no cost per student.

### **Scott High School- Junior Statesmen of America**

Scott requests permission for 12 students to travel to Crowne Plaza Hotel in Louisville, KY November 16-18, 2017 for the Kentucky Youth Assembly. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:2. Transportation will be via Queen City Transportation. Meals will be student packed. Cost per student is \$38. Funds have been secured for indigent students.

### **Scott High School- Drama Club**

Scott requests permission for 16 students to travel to Jenny Wiley Theatre in Pikeville, KY November 18, 2017 for the State Theatre Tournament. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:3. Transportation will be via District bus. Meals will be at the venue. There should be no cost per student. Club is seeking funding from Eagle Club.

### **Twenhofel Middle School- Archery Club**

Twenhofel requests permission for 48 students to travel to Mason County Intermediate School in Maysville, KY November 18, 2017 for an archery tournament. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:1. Transportation and meals are parent responsibility. There is no cost per student.

### **Ryland Heights Elementary- 5<sup>th</sup> Grade**

Ryland requests permission for 100 students to travel to Toyota Georgetown Facility in Georgetown, KY November 20 or 21, 2017. Due to tour limitations, approximately half of the students will go on November 20, and the remainder will tour on November 21. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio not to exceed 1:10. Transportation will be via District bus. Meals will be student packed. Cost per student is \$11. Funds have been secured for indigent students.

### **Kenton Elementary- 5<sup>th</sup> Grade**

Kenton requests permission for 112 students to travel to the State Capitol and Museum in Frankfort, KY November 21, 2017. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:4. Transportation will be via Queen City Transportation. Meals will be student packed. Cost per student is \$33. Funds have been secured for indigent students.

### **White's Tower Elementary- 5<sup>th</sup> Grade**

White's Tower requests permission for 92 students to travel to the State Capitol in Frankfort, KY November 21, 2017. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:4. Transportation will be via Queen City Transportation. Meals will be student packed. Cost per student is \$30. Funds have been secured for indigent students.

### **Dixie Heights High School- Girls Basketball**

**Kenton County Academies of Innovation and Technology- VEX Robotics**

KCAIT requests permission for 80 students to travel to Bryan Station High School in Lexington, KY January 20, 2018 for a VEX competition. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:10.

Transportation will be via Kenton County bus. Meals will be at student packed or pizza. There is no cost per student.

**Simon Kenton High School- Wrestling**

Simon Kenton requests permission for 25 students to travel to Lindsey Wilson High School in Columbia, KY January 26-27, 2018 for wrestling state duals. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:6. Transportation will be via Kenton County bus. Lodging will be in the Sleep Inn, Columbia, KY. Meals will be at Subway. Simon Kenton requests permission for 15 students to travel to All-Tech Arena in Lexington, KY February 15-17, 2018 for wrestling state. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:3. Transportation will be via Kenton County bus. Lodging will be at the Marriott Griffin Gate in Lexington, KY.
