


Hinsdale Secure Vestibule Entrance

The scope of work involved with the construction of a secure vestibule entrance at Hinsdale Elementary involves the erection of an addition to the original school. Through much research it was determined that the construction of a new addition to include an administrative office was more effective in addressing the secure entrance design challenge. The new entrance addition also establishes a future classroom addition building pad and relates well to future development of the site. Recent facility planning efforts explored opportunities to revise site circulation and expanded parking options for this campus. The proposed secure entrance is properly sited for future site changes.

The enclosure reflects a floor plan for the new entrance as well as an exterior elevation for the proposed addition. The new addition is being designed to connect to a future classroom addition. The wall sections established for future connectivity will be covered with metal wall panels. The metal panels establish a much cleaner construction project when the classrooms are built. The enclosure also includes a conceptual site plan that depicts the new addition.
