    - Expansion of Books for Babies through a partnership with Marion County Public Library, Friends of the Library, & the *Dolly Parton Imagination Library* - Every child from birth to 5 years receives a new book every month at their home; to date we have **559** active and 53 have graduated the program!
    - Born Learning Academies for October - GES 84, LES 48, WMES 12 families; CES begins in January
  - **Universal Pre-School**
    - Full STEAM Ahead Training at GRREC - 11/3/17 - Training for preschool instructional assistants and community partners; each participant received \$200 in materials to use in classrooms
