Dear Superintendent Watts:

On behalf of Morehead State University, I would like to inform you of a new recruitment and outreach program aimed at collaborating with our area school districts. I am writing to solicit your school district's assistance in a partnership with MSU.

The program, known as *Eagle Outreach*, encompasses small teams composed of high-level administrators and selected faculty and staff that will visit your campus to discuss courses, programs, majors, scholarship opportunities, student financial aid and other college-related items of interest to your students. Each team will be empowered to speak to various classes, thus enhancing the opportunities for your students.

We hope a team can visit your high school(s) this fall to speak with selected classes and students interested in Morehead State. We would also like to share with your guidance counselors, principals and teachers, news about the available scholarships. The second visit, early in the spring term, would ideally focus on speaking with other students who have an interest in MSU.

It is also our wish that each spring semester you will allow your high school principal and/or guidance counselor to bring a large group of promising juniors and seniors to visit our campus.

During the campus visit, your students will be attending basic informational sessions on how to apply to college, the structure of financial aid, additional scholarship opportunities, meet with the academic department(s) of their choice and a campus tour. We hope this will provide students with a true college adventure day.
