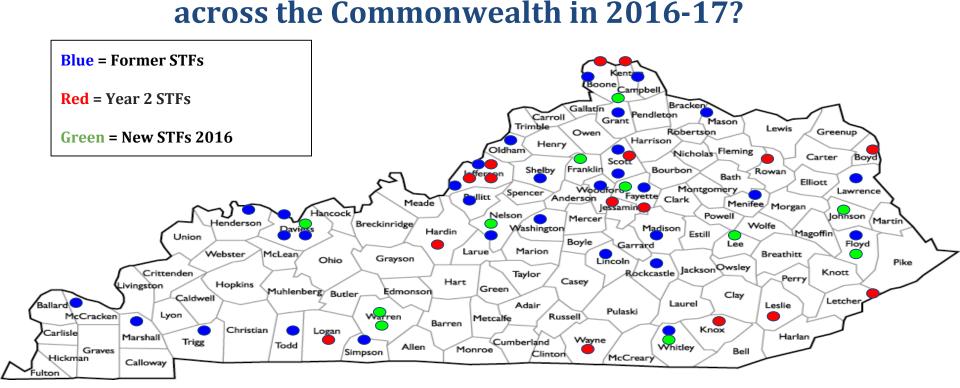

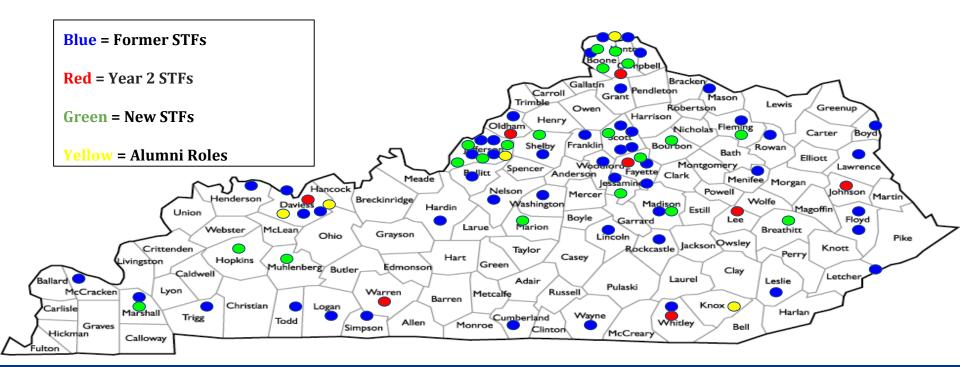

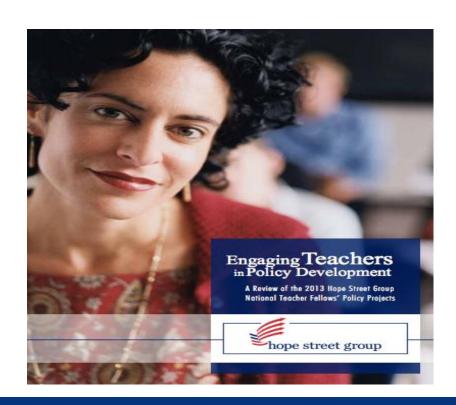
Who We Are

What We Do

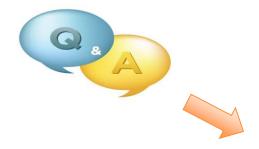
- Identify: what are the challenges?
