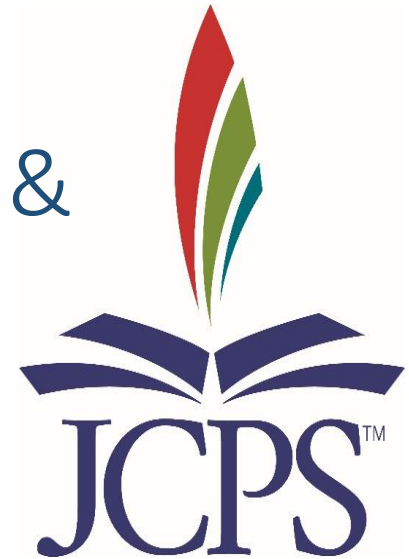


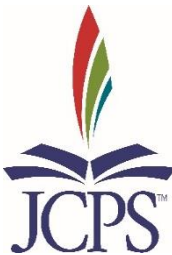

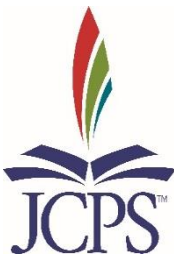
Updates to CDIP and CSIP Process

- The processes for the Comprehensive District and School Improvement Plans (CDIP and CSIPs) are being revised by the Kentucky Department of Education.
- Changes include:
 - Planning tool/platform has changed from ASSIST to EProve
 - From a single event to a multi-phase process, emphasizing continuous improvement
 - EProve allows for increased flexibility in plans while still supporting schools and districts in meeting KDE requirements
 - Emphasis on Key Core Work Processes

What to expect from 2017-2018 CDIP

- 5 required KDE goals: Proficiency, Gap, Growth, Transition Readiness, and Graduation
 - Additional JCPS Goals: Culture and Climate, Organizational Coherence

- A streamlined, more focused plan with emphasis on maximum impact activities
 - Elimination of bulky plan with repetitive strategies/activities

- Continuous improvement and updates to plan throughout the school year
 - Descriptions of current year activities and planning for 2018-2019 school year
