- BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION SKILL GROUPS WITH COUNSELOR (THESE ARE STUDENTS WHO HAVE RECEIVED 5 TEACHER REPORTS IN THE SPECIFIED TIME). SKILLSTREAMING PROGRAM IS USED : 5 STUDENTS
- BEHAVIOR MONITORING CHARTS/CHECK IN/OUT - PREPARED BY COUNSELOR: 15 STUDENTS. THERE ARE SEVERAL MORE CHARTS BEING USED, PREPARED AND MONITORED BY TEACHER
- STUDENTS RECEIVING INDIVIDUAL COUNSELING FROM OUTSIDE MENTAL HEALTH AGENCIES @ SCHOOL: 111 STUDENTS
- SMALL GROUPS ON IDENTIFIED NEED (GIRLS GROUP, SOCIAL SKILLS, ANGER MANAGEMENT): 3 GROUPS WITH 6-7 STUDENTS EACH
- ALL CLASSES COMPLETED 1 MONTH OF SECOND STEP LESSONS
- ALL STUDENTS RECEIVE CLASSROOM GUIDANCE LESSONS ONCE PER MONTH ON VARYING TOPICS (BULLYING, SOCIAL SKILLS, CAREER ID, ETC)

 - OF THESE 66 STUDENTS 65% COMPLETED BEHAVIOR INTERVENTION STRATEGY PAPERS
 - OF THESE 66 STUDENTS 12 HAVE BEEN PLACED ON A BEHAVIOR TRANSITION PLAN

 - ✓ NUMBER OF REFERRALS - 28
