- State level Kindergarten Readiness Scores have been released and as a state we are at 52%. We are above the state average.

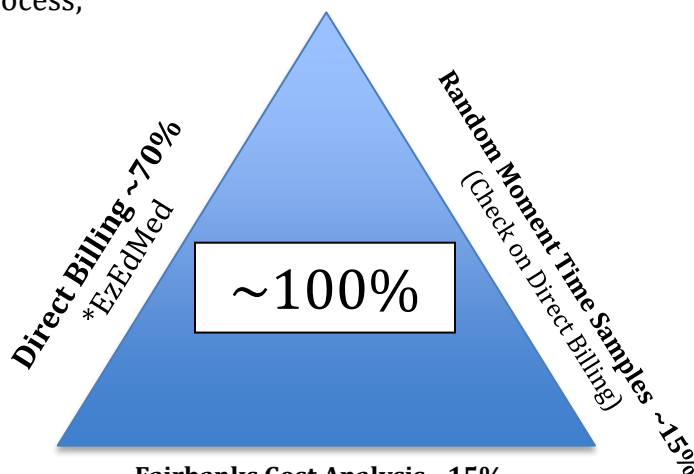
