Hardin County continues to make strides on state assessments, while continuing to make every effort to improve in areas needing additional support. College and career readiness, along with work ethic certifications continue to be a priority for our high schools students. The Early College & Career Center has provided opportunities for students to expand their knowledge and skill set for transitioning to the real world. School and district staff use SMART Goals to guide the work being done in the district for continued improvement.
