Heartland Elementary is a Literacy First school where reading is one of our top priorities. Students receive instruction on phonological awareness, phonics, vocabulary, fluency and comprehension through small groups. This allows teachers to provide explicit instruction that is directly focused on the skills of the child. Math is another subject taken very seriously at Heartland as teachers find exciting and engaging ways to challenge students to master their basic math facts. This school year our teachers are focused on various data results in order to teach students the specific skills they need in order to be proficient mathematicians. Other content areas such as writing, science and social studies are also very important and are taught daily in engaging and meaningful ways. All students at Heartland have weekly access to art, music, and physical education. There are also various extracurricular activities offered at Heartland such as Beta Club, academic team, chorus, art club, and archery to name a few. This year we have added monthly clubs where students get to participate as an incentive for being responsible and respectful students. 
