Lincoln Trail Elementary (LTE) is a kindergarten through fifth grade facility outside of the city limits of Elizabethtown with 500 students. LTE employs 38 certified teachers and 14 classified employees. LTE is a Title 1 school with an average of our student body at 38% Free/Reduced Lunch. The number of students that move in and out of our school district has increased in the last 3 years, as well as the number of students being cared for by grandparents or foster families. With the addition of a new Special Education Program (PASS) and an increase in the number of our student population qualifying for special education services, that particular gap group, according to the KDE report card, has increased. Individual student needs are met though a variety of programs including special education resource classes, ESL Program, After School Childcare Program, Extended School Services Daytime Waiver, partnerships with Elizabethtown Community and Technical College and Western Kentucky University, Gifted and Talented Program, and Title 1. Related Arts classes are provided through PE, Art, Music, and Library/Computer. Lincoln Trail houses a fully-functional Family Resource Center that helps remove learning barriers for students and works with families to obtain needed services.

The average years of experience for certified staff at LTE is 15 years. Various sources of data were used to determine priority areas of improvement for LTE. A priority for improvement is Novice reduction in the area of reading for the non-duplicated gap groups from grades 3-5. State assessment results have documented deficiencies in the area of writing for all students. LTE has an improvement goal to increase the number of proficient and



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distinguished writers, while reducing the number of novice and apprentice .specifically in that content area.
