**History/Background:**


For many years Floyd County has entered into Non-Resident Contracts with Paintsville Independent, Pikeville Independent, Martin, Magoffin, Knott, Johnson and Pike Counties. All of the Non-Resident contracts contain the following restrictions clause: The Superintendent has the authority to determine the acceptance of non-resident students on a case by case basis. Transportation to and from school is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. The student may be transferred back to the county of residence unless they make acceptable academic progress (on grade level), be in regular attendance (not a truant) and demonstrate acceptable behavior (no suspension level offenses).
