

## LES Board Report

### January 2017

- All students in grades kindergarten through sixth grade have completed their winter MAP benchmarking tests. The students were challenged to meet their individual MAP goals and all students worked hard to do their best on these tests. A data chart will be shared with the Board of Education members at the January board meeting.
- We held our 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Recognition Assembly on Friday, January 19<sup>th</sup>. We are very proud of the students' accomplishments. Below are some of the highlights:
  - ✓ **55** total students were on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter Honor/Super Honor Roll. The total number of students on Super Honor Roll was **23**.
  - ✓ We have 33 intermediate students needing to be on a *Contract to Pass* (Students have a contract if they have failed one or more class.). We continue to implement a multitude of interventions for students on a *Contract to Pass*. These include: individualized meetings, tutoring, counseling, incentives, etc.
  - ✓ **129 tie-dye** and **black** MAP ribbons were distributed on Friday for the students' recent performance on the winter MAP testing. Students in all grades K – 6 earn these for performing at the 80% or above on the MAP benchmarking test.
  - ✓ We gave out **405** MAP goal ribbons (green, white and yellow) to students for meeting and/or exceeding their individual goals.
  - ✓ **132** Little Devils had perfect attendance for the entire 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter of school.
- LES Committee Work –
  - PBIS Team – This team will meet in the months ahead to reflect and analyze trends and effectiveness for our first year of implementation.
  - Curriculum Team – The curriculum team continues to work to finalize the LES Writing Plan and to update/revise all other subject curriculum next steps.
  - Instructional Strategies Team – This team will work collaboratively to ensure that all needed CSIP documents are submitted in a timely manner to the state department.
- Our Annual LES Holiday Program held on Friday, December 15<sup>th</sup> was again a huge success with over 400 community and family guests joining us for the afternoon program.
