Issue:

Students are flying Allegiant Air and upon arrival they will be using Total Transportation Solutions to transport from airport to Universal Studios and depart Universal Studios back to the airport using this same carrier. Students will return on Allegiant Air.


Budget/Financial Issues:


All finances are paid for by dance team members.
