#### **Lesson Plans**

3-LS2-1. Construct an argument that some animals form groups that help members survive.

CC.W.3.2 Write informative/explanatory texts in which they introduce a topic, use facts and definitions to develop points, and provide a concluding statement or section.

We have been studying different ecosystems in science. We will go to Bernheim and participate in an educator-led class called "Exploring the Bernheim Ecosystem.†Students will learn about the three habitats at Bernheim: forest, pond, and prairie. Students will explore the habitats and the organisms belonging to each of them. Students will learn about interdependence, survival, and adaptation within these three habitats.

When we return from Bernheim, students will debrief on their findings from the field trip. We will have a turn and talk where students will be asked to share big ideas they took away from this experience. Then we will have a whole group conversation about our observations.
