Activities

The FRC has provided breakfast for the Kindergarten and preschool Children Inc. students.

The application for a 2st Century Community Learning Center Grant was completed and submitted by the YMCA and we are still awaiting the awarding of those grants.

The Family Resource Center provided each student grades P through 5 at Southgate with a Holiday Book and CD entitled “Mr. Holidays Presents The Roof Top Hop.”

The Family Resource Center provided Christmas assistance for 52 Southgate children and Holiday meals for 32 families.

The FRYSC budget was hit with a \$5296.92 (9% of our total budget) reduction in funding from the Governor for this current fiscal year. That reduction will be reflected in the Fourth Quarter payment to our fiscal agent, the Bellevue School District. The reduction effectively eliminates the small remaining money we had left in our budget for expenses and reduces the Coordinator’s salary by some \$2300. Mr. Smith, Bellevue Superintendent, has committed to covering both staff salaries for the remainder of this school year.

The 2018-2020 Program Plan is being written by Mr. Sanders and will be presented to the FRYSC Advisory Council at the February 20th Special Meeting. The meeting is being held to review and approve the Program Plan as well as the budget reductions resulting from the Governor’s cut.

It is important to note that FRYSC was not included as a line-item in the governor’s proposed budget. What that means for our future is uncertain at this time.
