Teaching and Learning Initiatives & Highlights

- The Curriculum Department's work focused on these main areas this month:
 - Innovative Approaches to Literacy Grant (IAL) implementation revisions
 - Preparing for KPREP Spring Testing with Building Assessment Coordinators
 - Learning about changes to the new KDE Accountability System for schools/districts
 - 2019 Federal Fund allocations for 95% hold harmless
 - Completing ACCESS Testing & planning for changes in our EL staff
 - Gaining knowledge on the new Title IV, Part A funding that is now available, completing the intent to participate process, & learning about the allowable expenditures for these monies

District/School Improvement Highlights

- All schools completed ACCESS testing with all of our EL students
