### **Review Item:**

2018-2020 Executive Budget Recommendation regarding P-12 education

### **Rationale:**

To discuss and review the current draft of the 2018-2020 Executive Budget.

### **Applicable Statute or Regulation:**

KRS 48.100

### **History/Background:**

***Existing Policy:*** The Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) submitted the 2018-2020 Agency Biennial Budget Request to the Governor's Office on November 1, 2017.

***Summary:*** At the October 2017 meeting, the KBE approved the KDE 2018-2020 Biennial Budget Request. This request was submitted to the Office of the State Budget Director (OSBD) on November 1, 2017. OSBD reviewed and considered the contents of the request for inclusion in the Governor's 2018-2020 Executive Budget Recommendation. HB200 was introduced on January 16, 2018, and passed out of the House on March 1, 2018. The presentation to the KBE will provide an update on the bill's progress toward final approval.

***Budget Impact:*** Sufficient funding for education programs is essential for all students to achieve academic proficiency.
