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Division 06: Woods and Plastics

06.01: 2017.03.15 – Casework installation was actively underway in several first floor spaces. Interior window stools were also being installed.

Division 07: Thermal and Moisture Protection

07.01: 2017.03.12 – Metal siding installation was complete except for a few sections at the North elevation, at the former entrance, and some smaller cut pieces at various locations. Several deficiencies were identified and conveyed to the contractor at a subsequent meeting.

Division 08: Doors and Windows

08.01: 2017.03.12 – Installation of the final lower level window was in progress.

08.02: 2017.03.12 – Exterior hollow metal doors were installed at the center stair, leaving only the lower level exterior doors as uninstalled.

08.03: 2017.03.15 – Aluminum window installation was complete with the exception of interior mullion trim between units which will be installed following solid surface window stool installation. 08.04: 2017.03.15 – Interior vestibule doors were being installed.

Division 09: Finishes

09.01: 2017.03.12 – Drywall had been installed at the entry lobby walls.

Division 10: Specialties

10.01: 2017.03.12 – White board and tack board installation was complete in all but one second floor classroom, all lower level classrooms, and the corridors. Material was on-site and awaiting installation. 10.02: 2017.03.15 – Operable partition track was in place between the first floor resource classrooms.

10.03: 2017.03.15 – Unacceptable gaps between white boards and tack boards were observed. The contractor was directed to investigate for correction.

Division 20-28: MEP

20-28.01: 2017.03.12 – Approximately 90% of first floor light fixtures were energized. Only missing corridor fixtures and restrooms were not live. The electrician was actively wiring second floor classroom fixtures. 20-28.02: 2017.03.12 – The plumber was actively installing second floor plumbing fixtures. First floor fixture installation was complete with the exception of sinks in casework which was set to arrive later in the week. 20-28.03: 2017.03.12 – Factory startup for portions of the mechanical system was complete and some units were actively running.

Division 31: Earthwork

31.01: 2017.03.12 – The east classroom walk-out area was rough-graded.


