CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Ramona Malone called the meeting to order and asked for a roll call. The following were present: Ramona Malone, Dr. Smith-Morrow, Melissa Sheffel, Theresa Miller, and Matthew Scott.

EXPULSION FINDINGS

The following action was taken by the board:

The board found there was clear and convincing evidence that the Student Code of Conduct was violated on the grounds of terroristic threatening in the second degree while on school property, which is a violation of the Newport Board of Education policies and in violation of KRS 508.078. The decision was made to expel said student from all schools and school activities for one calendar year, with services, which means student will not be able to enroll in a KY public school until February 26, 2019. Student is banned from entering any property of Newport Independent Schools during the period of expulsion. Failure to follow this ban is grounds for arrest by the Newport Police Dept. on the charge of criminal trespass.

On MOTION BY SMITH-MORROW AND SECONDED BY SCOTT the board unanimously approved this decision.
