## School Safety Measures



- Building relationships with students.
- Increased police presence at all campuses.
- Ongoing discussion with police about safety.
- Visitor access blocked to CES main hallway.
- Gym doors closed at CES in the morning.
- CMS and CHS students enter through front doors only.
- More staff members in hallways and restrooms.
- Installed additional security cameras, both inside and outside of all campuses.
- Emergency dispatch center will have access to all CIS security cameras.
- Police presence at after-school and evening events.
- Increased mental health services with KidSpOt partnership.
- Drop-off sites monitored by staff members.
- Metal-detecting wands on site.
- Visitors must be buzzed in and sign log to enter.
- Increased awareness of safety precautions.
- Dialogue about hiring School Resource Officer.
- Safety tipline link to be added to CIS website.
- Active shooter training discussed for employees.
- Crisis communication plan to be updated.
- Safety drills to be assessed and updated.
- Continued use of One Call notification system to notify parents of important events and incidents.
