- *Smart Solutions: Dog is to be dropped off at 9:30 am, and picked up at 3:30 pm. There will be a private lesson immediately following from 3:30-5:00 pm. The following guidelines will be followed during Smart Solutions portion of the program.
- 1. Education for human and canine
- 2. Addressing issues and complications to move forward
- 3. Review for the human, and teaching "fixed" skills/space
- 4. Human condition, relaxation for canine. Teaching canine "unfixed" space
- 5. Review challenges. State of mind conditioning
- *Obedience. The following guidelines will be following during the Obedience portion of the program.
- 1. Get the behavior (teach human to get behavior, teach canine lure, capturing, shape, mold)
- 2. Marking- heart and soul of capture and shaping
- 3. Reinforcement/Fade- mix up expectations
- 4. Schedules of reinforcement (lure without mark/reward)
- 5. Elicit- understanding I.Q. and how to use with expectations, addressing obedience
