A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING (1) THE GATEWAY ADD ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF MOREHEAD TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT A 2018 RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM GRANT APPLICATION (2) THE HOLDING IN RESERVE OF 20% OF THE ESTIMATED PROJECT COSTS FOR MATCH AND (3) GIVING MAYOR JAMES T. TRENT THE AUTHORITY TO SIGN ALL ADMINISTRATIVE FORMS ASSOCIATED WITH THE 2018 RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Morehead proposes to acquire/develop/or renovate recreational resources to provide for the health and well-being of the general public, and

WHEREAS, the City of Morehead intends to make an application, through a grant prepared by the Gateway ADD, to the Kentucky Department for Local Government for assistance under the Recreational Trails Program (RTP), federally funded by the Federal Highway Administration, and

WHEREAS, the Recreational Trails Program is limited to funding a maximum of eighty percent (80%) of the estimated project costs, estimated at \$______, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Morehead (1) approves of the Gateway ADD preparation and submission of a 2018 Recreational Trails Program application titled "Morehead Memorial Tree Walk Park Rehabilitation Project" (2) hold in reserve twenty percent (20%) of the estimated project costs, or \$______, for the purpose of matching the Recreational Trails Program assistance, and (3) giving Mayor James T. Trent the authority to sign all administrative forms associated with the 2018 Recreational Trails Program application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event a grant is awarded, the City of Morehead understands that it will sign assurances to comply with all applicable Federal and State laws, rules, and regulations, especially Title VI of the Civil Rights Act and Section 504 of the 1973 Rehabilitation Act.
