## Modification No. 01

THIS MODIFICATION, made and entered into as of this 27th day of September, 2017, by and between The Greater Louisville Workforce Development Board, Inc. d/b/a/ KentuckianaWorks, 410 West Chestnut Street, Suite 200, Louisville, Kentucky 40202 ("the Board"), as the Administrative Entity for the Greater Louisville Workforce Development Board and the Board of Education of Jefferson County Kentucky, 3332 Newburg Road. Louisville, Kentucky 40232 ("the Contractor").

## WITNESSETH:

Modification to Previous Agreement:

Pursuant to Part 11, "Modifications to Agreement," the parties to this Modification Agreement No. 01 mutually agree to make the following modification to the Original Agreement previously entered into by and between the Board and the Contractor in Contract No. 211-400-18.

The purpose of this modification is to make the following adjustments:

1. Reallocate budget line items from staff fringe to educational materials and youth development activities as outlined in the attached budget.

Note that these changes have no overall impact to the original, approved budget. The budget remains the same at \$565,125.30.

2. Change the annual goal for performance targets in light of new programmatic emphases and performance measures being adopted under WIOA. New performance targets are outlined in the attached document titled "Quantitative Measures."
