



Charter School Performance Framework

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Pursuant to KRS 160.1596 “the performance provisions within a charter contract shall be based on a performance framework that sets forth the academic and operational performance indicators, measures, and metrics to be used by the authorizer to evaluate each public charter school.” The framework shall be utilized throughout the life of the charter school to evaluate processes, outcomes, and provide important information to the Jefferson County Board of Education regarding a charter school’s performance and sustainability. It shall be integrated in the charter school monitoring system and shall serve as the guidepost for future decision making regarding renewal, nonrenewal, revocation, and closure. The framework aligns with the National Association of Charter School Authorizers’ Principals and Standards for Quality Charter School Authorizing (2012), which states that authorizers should, through performance framework, set clear expectations “under which schools will be evaluated, using objective and verifiable measures of student achievement as the primary measure of school quality.”

Framework Structure

The framework includes five main levels of information: Indicators, Measures, Metrics, Targets, and Ratings.

- Indicators—General categories of performance
- Measures—General means to evaluate an aspect of an indicator
- Metrics—Method of quantifying a measure
- Targets—Thresholds that signify success in meeting the standard for a specific measure
- Ratings—Assignment of charter school performance into rating categories based on how the school performs against the framework targets

Each key indicator shall be assessed as to whether school performance in each measure:

Mission and Vision

a. Has the school established a mission and vision that are clear to all stakeholders? The mission is a statement of the fundamental purpose of the school, describing why it exists. The vision statement outlines how the school shall operate, what it shall achieve in the long term, and how it shall achieve the mission. b. Is the school in compliance with applicable education program statutes, rules, and regulations?	Metrics: Data requests, assurance, school calendars, student records, reports, and KDE reports
c. Is the school in compliance with special education and 504 requirements under state and federal law?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, federal and state reporting requirements, policy documents, evaluation of special education program, 504 plan, student files, student data, and staff interviews
d. Is the school in compliance with state and federal requirements regarding the rights of English Language Learner (ELL) students?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, federal and state reporting requirements, policy documents, evaluation of ELL Program, student files, student data, and staff interviews
e. Is the school in compliance with state and federal requirements regarding the rights of students identified as Homeless/Unaccompanied? c. Is the school complying with non-financial data reporting requirements?	Metrics: information including, but not limited to, safe schools reporting, required reporting included in charter contract, policies, and student files

g. Does the school ensure strong student enrollment retention from year to year?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, student files and enrollment data
h. Does the school comply with requirements regarding student voluntary withdrawal?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, student files and enrollment data
i. Does the school actively recruit a student population as set out in its goals in the charter school contract?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, student files and enrollment data
j. Does the school materially comply with teacher credentialing requirements under state law?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, school reporting requirements as described in charter contract, policies, and interviews
k. Does the school comply with laws regarding employee rights?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, school reporting requirements as described in charter contract, handbooks, interviews, and policies
l. Does the school complete required background checks?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, school reporting requirements as described in charter contract, policies, and interviews

b. Has the school demonstrated material compliance with 704 KAR 7:160, “Use of Physical Restraint and Seclusion?”	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, school reporting requirements as described in charter contract, policies, and interviews

c. Does the school comply with all health requirements?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, school reporting requirements as described in charter contract, policies, and interviews
d. Does the school comply with all safety requirements, and has it submitted an emergency management response plan as required under KRS 158.162?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, school reporting requirements as described in charter contract, policies, and interviews
e. Does the school effectively give and receive information from parents/guardians and students?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, school reporting requirements as described in charter contract, school communications, interviews, and policies
f. Does the school materially comply with facilities requirements as provided in the charter contract and pursuant to applicable law?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, school reporting requirements as described in charter contract, policies, and interviews
g. Does the school materially comply with transportation requirements as provided in the charter contract and pursuant to applicable law?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, school reporting requirements as described in charter contract, policies, and interviews
h. Does the school materially comply with student information security requirements as provided under the charter contract and pursuant to applicable law?	Metrics: Information including, but not limited to, school reporting requirements as described in charter contract, policies, and interviews
