




- I. Opening Business
- The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m.
 - All members present with the exception of Heather Banks. Also in attendance was Dixie Combs.
 - JoDean Howard made a motion to approve the agenda as presented and Boyd Griffith seconded the motion. All members were in favor.
 - Cathy McCune made a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting. JoDean Howard seconded and all members were in favor.
- II. Student Improvement
- Dixie Combs asked for consideration to approve the following Student Improvement items:

 - The council considered the activities for a blanket approval. Cathy McCune made a motion to approve the activities as presented and JoDean Howard seconded the motion. All members were in favor.
- III. School Improvement
- The council was presented with a copy of the current MUNIS Budget Report. Mr. Hamilton noted the increased budget amount due to a donation that the school received to fund the End of Year Trip to Kentucky Kingdom in May. Boyd Griffith made a motion to approve the budget as presented and Crystal Strong seconded the motion. All members were in favor.
 - Mr. Hamilton informed the council that as far as staffing goes, there haven’t been any updates from the Board of Education. The high school is working on rooms to get them ready for move in before the end of the year. Some rooms are set to be ready to move into as early as next week.
 - Mr. Hamilton took a moment to commend the RTI teachers and their work on student achievement. Reading Plus Data shows an increase of up to five reading levels for some students. The Reading Plus and ALEKS Math programs have been used effectively in the RTI classes, and data confirms this.
- IV. JoDean Howard made a motion to enter into executive session. Crystal Strong seconded and all members were in favor. Boyd Griffith made a motion to come out

of executive session and Cathy McCune seconded. All members were in favor.

Action Taken: Recommend Austin Strong for ESS Instructor Position.


