

## Board Report for 4/23/2018

- As of 4/23/18 – 36 seniors have received 112 acceptance letters to 33 different schools.
- As of 4/23/18 – 28 seniors have received \$2,786,000 in scholarship offers
- Lydia Workman will be our RYL (Regional Youth Leadership) representative for the 2018-2019 school year.
- Motivational speaker Kevin Marcelle Johnson visited DHS on April 16. He presented a message of hope and “the power of the apple seed” to students in grades 7-12.
- The ASVAB test was administered by Ron Pinkerton on April 11
