#### **Teaching and Learning Initiatives & Highlights**

- The Curriculum Department's work focused on these main areas this month:
  - Assisting with preparing for & monitoring the administration of all state assessments with Building Assessment Coordinators
  - 2019 Federal Fund allocations for 95% hold harmless
  - SIG Grant budget planning with Newport High School
  - Planning & conducting the 50/50 Committee meetings to work on revisions to the current Certified Evaluation Plan to meet the new KDE requirements
  - Conducting calibration walkthroughs with school leaders
  - Conducting Instructional Technology Committee meetings for school leaders & teacher leaders
  - Coordinated & participated in Google Level 1 training during Spring Break
    - A total of 44 teachers & school leaders attended the 2-day training
    - Many of them have already successfully taken the certification test

## **District/School Improvement Highlights**

- · Mrs. Gilkison assisted Mr. Middleton with the Spring Site Visits with Principals as part of their evaluations
- The Curriculum Department will be meeting with each building to monitor & review their 30-60-90 day plans during the first week of May

### **Assessment Updates**

- BACs are in the process of planning for Spring Testing
- NHS successfully completed KOSSA testing
- Spring MAP testing is currently occurring at NIS & NHS and will begin at NPS in May
- EOC Field Tests are being given at NHS & NRS from April 16 to April 27
- ACT make-ups will occur on April 24 for any student in grade 11 that was absent on the original administration date
