Lesson Plans

This trip has already received full approval as of March 27, 2018. We are resubmitting this trip because the date of the trip has changed from June 6 to June 8 due to the last day of school being changed. The trip itinerary and all other details remain the same.

BMS 7th Grade Students will visit to the KY Science Center to explore 3 floors of exhibits. These exhibits are centered around The World We Create (physics), Discovery Gallery (anthropology, archaeology, and paleontology), The World Around Us (life science and ecology), and The World Within Us (biology). These are exhibits are directly linked to the content students have learned in their 7th grade science class this year. These standards addressed by these exhibits include KCAS 07-PS2-3, 07-PS2-5, 07-PS3-2, 07-PS3-4, 07-PS3-5, 07-LS1-1, 07-LS1-2, 07-LS1-3, 07-LS1-4, 07-LS1-5, 07-LS1-6, 07-LS1-7.

After viewing the exhibits students will watch a movie in the Science Center's IMAX Theatre. Students will view the movie "Dream Big 3D". The summary for this 42 minute movie states "Engineering: an exciting, creative, heroic realm where the optimists of today are creating the life-saving, world-altering marvels that will make for a safe, connected, and awe-inspiring tomorrow."
