- I. Call to order/Roll Call
Marlene Hamilton made the motion to call the meeting to order. Missy Mann seconded the motion, with all members voting in favor.
- II. Reading and approval of last meeting minutes
Chris Banks made the motion to approve the previous meeting minutes. Tammy Keene seconded the motion, with all members voting in favor.
- III. Budget

- IV. Student data

- V. Proficient and Distinguished from KPREP 2017

- VI. FRYSC

- VII. PBIS
Mr. Fugate discussed district wide PBIS system for the upcoming school year. He explained all elementary schools in the district would be similar, each school would have a team which would meet often for training. The team would include a data person, back-up data person, coach, and administrator (5-6 people). He suggested that it be the Leadership team from MRC, which would include, Heather Hall, Kristal Combs, Tammy Keene, Marlene Hamilton, Lisa Miller, and Jason Fugate. The council agreed. Chris

IX. Student clubs


Mr. Fugate discussed implementing student clubs at MRC. Some possible suggestions of clubs would be hunting/fishing, drama, cooking, photography, etc.

X. Other concerns


String of Lights, fund raiser to raise money to buy food for MRC's less fortunate families, will finish up on February 26th. The classes that raised the most money will be rewarded.


