Lesson Plan â€” Land Navigation Practical Exercise

A. Training Objective:

Task:	Selected students will participate in practical exercise (PE) performing individual land navigation skills.
Conditions:	Selected students will be given a map of the terrain of the training area and a compass during daylight hours in order to compete to qualify for Junior ROTC orienteering ribbon.

Training Standard: Within a 75 minute period each student will have the opportunity to plot six locations on their map and to use their map and compass to find the corresponding location on the ground. Each student will have to find at least four correct points in order to qualify for the orienteering ribbon.

B. Intermediate Training Objective: Every student will be taught to read a map, plot a location on a map, and use a compass and to safely move through a wooded area in order to find a predetermined location.

C. Administrative Instructions:

1. When training will be given: Preliminary training will be conducted at North Bullitt High School in preparation for the practical exercise.
2. Training location: Camp Crooked Creek Boy Scout Camp, Kentucky.
3. Date of training: September 27, 2018
4. Who will be trained: Selected students from the various periods (approximately 150 cadets from freshman through senior).
5. Principal and assistant trainers: MAJ (Ret) Kevin W. Clark, Sr., (SAI) and 1SG (Ret) Eugene Siler (AI). Range safety assistance various military recruiters.
6. Training aids and equipment: The North Bullitt High School Junior ROTC Department has organic equipment to accomplish this practical exercise.

D. Sequence of activities and estimate time: Requested time of departure at 7:30 a.m. and return time of 1:30 p.m.

E. Safety restrictions: All students participating in this training will receive safety instruction prior to the aforementioned training.
