Resolution of Adoption of the Gateway Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan 2018 Update

WHEREAS, certain areas of **Morehead, Kentucky** are subject to periodic Flooding, Tornadoes, Severe Thunderstorms and Hailstorms, Severe Winter Storms, Landslides and Land Subsidence, Earthquakes, Forest Fires, Drought, Extreme Temperature, Karst, Sinkholes, and other natural hazards that have potential to cause damages to people and properties within the area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Morehead desires to prepare and mitigate for such natural hazards; and

WHEREAS, under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, the United States Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires that local jurisdictions have in place a FEMA-approved Hazard Mitigation Action Plan as a condition of receipt of certain future Federal Mitigation Funding after November 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the **Gateway Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan 2018 Update** was developed in accordance with the regulations of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and the guidance provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency; and

WHEREAS, to assist cities and counties in meeting this requirement, the Gateway Area Development District has facilitated the development of a multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan covering member jurisdictions of the **Gateway Area Development District** including **Morehead, Kentucky**;

NOW, therefore be it resolved that the **City of Morehead** hereby:

- 1. Adopts those portions of the Gateway Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan that pertain to **Morehead, Kentucky;** and
- 2. Vests the Rowan County Office of Emergency Management with the responsibility, authority, and means to:
 - a. Inform all concerned parties of this action
 - b. Develop an addendum to this Hazard Mitigation Plan Update if the jurisdiction's unique situation warrants such an addendum.
- 3. Appoints the Gateway Area Development District Regional Mitigation Committee to assure that the Hazard Mitigation Plan be reviewed according to the Plan Maintenance Procedures in section 3.5 of the Plan and that any needed adjustment to the Plan be developed and presented to the Rowan County Local Hazard Mitigation Committee and to the City of Morehead for consideration.
- Agrees to consider any other official actions as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objective of the Gateway Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan 2018 Update for Morehead, Kentucky.
