Early Childhood Learning

- End of the Year preschool celebration will be on May 16th.
- Preschool Partnership Grant RFA should be released soon.
- We received a huge hit with preschool dollars as a result of the latest budget. We will be receiving ~\$50,000 less in the 18-19 school year.
- Book-a-week update: We have provided over 2,500 books this year and each preschool student will receive a summer packet of 5 books and activities.

Special Education/504

- We have a few Special Education Teachers that are submitting proposals for the state CEC conference in the fall.
- Special Education teachers are participating in the end of the year instructional trainings.
- Summer professional learning is being discussed.

Medicaid Billing System

- As of 5/14/18 we have increased our direct billing by \$10,000 from our total last year.
- For our students who qualify for special education, are Medicaid eligible, and parent gives us permission to bill we should be recouping almost 100% of costs for the following services;
 - Speech Therapy
 - Occupational Therapy
 - Mental Health Therapy
 - Physical Therapy
 - Some evaluations
 - Special Transportation (on days related services are provided)
 - Health Aide and Nursing Services (toileting, feedings, medication administration, etc.)
