 - Assisting with preparing for & monitoring the administration of all state assessments with Building Assessment Coordinators
 - Planning & conducting the 50/50 Committee meetings to work on revisions to the current Certified Evaluation Plan to meet the new KDE requirements
 - Conducting Instructional Technology Committee meetings for school leaders & teacher leaders
 - Conducted meetings with each school to monitor & review their 30-60-90 day plans

 - Amy conducted Summative Evaluation meetings with all of the members of the department
