

School Board Proposal for Summer Food Service Program: Offered at both schools for breakfast and lunch.

Dayton High School: Julie Rubemeyer will be conducting enrichment classes with students from June 11 – July 6. 21<sup>st</sup> Century will be operate during summer months from June 4 to June 28. We will provide breakfast before program begins and lunch while students are present. Expected meal times are 8:00-8:45 (breakfast), 11:15- 12:15 (lunch). We will continue to offer breakfast and lunch at these times through Friday, July 27 not including Wednesday July 4. One food service personnel needed for DHS program from June 4 to July 27, not including July 4, or 39 days, from 7:30-12:30, or 5 hrs (does not include a 30-minute lunch break.)

Lincoln Elementary School: Will provide many summer school programs from June 4 – August 3. Expected meal times are 8:45-9:30 (breakfast); 11:45-12:45 (lunch). We will continue to offer breakfast and lunch at these times through Friday, July 27 not including Wednesday July 4. One food service personnel needed for LES program from June 4 to July 27, not including July 4, or 39 days, from 8:00-1:00, or 5 hrs (does not include an unpaid 30-minute lunch break.)

Summer Food Service menu will include donated foods leftover from NSLP and SBP, in addition to other ordered foods, and will be posted weekly, by Friday the week before. Menus will be posted on Dayton High School and Lincoln Elementary School websites, while paper menus will be available in the cafeterias, at Front office of each school, and posted in the District Board Office.
