Field Trip Requests:

Dixie Heights High School- Track- Qualifying Event

Dixie requests permission for 10 students to travel to University of Kentucky in Lexington, KY May 18-19, 2018 for the State Track & Field meet. Supervision was provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 7:10. Transportation was via District bus. Lodging was at LaQuinta Inn Lexington South/Hamburg 100 Canebrake Dr. Lexington, KY 40509. There was no cost per student.

Scott High School- Track- Qualifying Event

Scott requests permission for 30 students to travel to University of Kentucky in Lexington, KY May 18, 2018 for the State Track & Field meet. Supervision was provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:2. Transportation was via District bus. Meals were provided by parents. There was no cost per student.

Woodland Middle School- Track- Qualifying Event

Woodland requests permission for 1 student to travel to Louisville, KY May 26, 2018 for the Middle School State Track meet. Supervision was provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:1. Transportation, meals and lodging were parent responsibility. Cost per student is \$60. Funds have been arranged for indigent students.

Twenhofel Middle School- Track- Qualifying Event

Twenhofel requests permission for 20 students to travel to Louisville, KY May 26, 2018 for the Middle School State Track meet. Supervision was provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:7. Transportation, meals and lodging were parent responsibility. There is no cost per student.

Woodland Middle School- Archery- Qualifying Event

Woodland requests permission for 23 students to travel to the KY Expo Center in Louisville, KY June 7, 2018 for the NASO World Archery Tournament. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:1. Transportation, meals and lodging are parent responsibility. Cost per student is \$35. Funds have been arranged for indigent students.

Twenhofel Middle School- Archery- Qualifying Event

Twenhofel requests permission for 5 students to travel to the KY Expo Center in Louisville, KY June 7-9, 2018 for the NASO World Archery Tournament. Supervision will be provided by staff and parents at a ratio of 1:1. Transportation, meals and lodging are parent responsibility. There is no cost per student.

Scott High School- Girls Basketball

Scott requests permission for 10 students to travel to Ball State University in Muncie, IN June 15, 2018 for basketball team camp. Supervision will be provided by staff at a ratio of 2:5. Transportation is via District bus. Meals will be at Frisch's in North Bend, OH and Wendy's in Muncie, IN. Cost per student is \$30. Funds have been secured for indigent students.

College Career Bootcamp

Dixie, Scott and Simon Kenton High Schools request permission for 30 students to travel to University of Kentucky in Lexington, KY and to the Toyota facility in Georgetown, KY July 12, 2018 as part of the College/Career Bootcamp. Supervision will be provided by staff at a ratio of 1:10. Transportation is via Queen City Transportation. There is no cost per student. The Family Resource Centers are sponsoring the trip and will provide lunch.
