Following are status reports on the following projects:

### BALLYSHANNON MIDDLE SCHOOL (BG #15-279 / REH #129-1214-A)

Century Construction continues to make progress and is nearing completion with the focus currently on the final interior finishes. The project is anticipated to be complete prior to the start of school.

# BOONE COUNTY AREA TECHNOLOGY CENTER - VENTILATION SYSTEM (BG #18-177 / REH #129-517-B)

The preconstruction meeting has been held, shop drawing submittal reviews have been ongoing, and Blau Mechanical is commencing work this week. Construction activities are anticipated to take approximately sixty days.
