MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF MOREHEAD, KENTUCKY AND ROWAN COUNTY ARTS PROMOTION FOUNDATION

WITNESSETH, THAT:

WHEREAS, the City desires to engage Rowan County Arts to serve as a house for local and regional arts to enrich the quality of life of the citizens of Morehead and bring in tourism to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises aforesaid and in further consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, and agreements herein and in consideration of the mutual benefits to the City, the parties hereby agree as follows:

Section I: Duties

- a. Rowan County Arts shall facilitate multiple art forms including, painting, sculpture, textile arts, multi-media and the performing arts such as theatre and musical performances.
- b. Rowan County Arts shall provide art education programs for all age group contributing to the quality of life for the citizens of the City.
- c. Rowan County Arts shall work with downtown businesses and other organizations to bring events to the community that will increase tourism in the City.
- d. Rowan County Arts shall permit for a fee usage of their facility for other non-art related events such as weddings, receptions, business meetings and school functions.
- e. Rowan County Arts shall provide the City with written and oral semi-annual reports detailing their involvement in the community and progress made toward the duties specified above. Said reports shall be made at the June and December Meetings

Section II: Term

This Agreement shall be effective from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019.

Section III: Compensation

For services rendered under this Agreement the City shall pay to Rowan County Arts the sum of Eight Thousand (\$8,000.00) Dollars, said payment being due to Rowan County Arts within thirty days of submission of its invoice to the City, but not before July 1, 2018. The City shall not be responsible for any other cost or expense unless agreed to in writing by the parties.

Section IV: Severability and Limited Enforceability

It is understood and agreed, that should any portion of any clause or paragraph of this Agreement be deemed too broad to permit enforcement to its fullest extent, then such restriction shall be enforced to a maximum extent permitted by law, and the City and Rowan County Arts hereby consent and agree that such scope may be modified accordingly in any proceeding brought to enforce such restriction. Further, it is agreed that should any provision in this Agreement be entirely unenforceable, then the remaining provisions of the Agreement shall not be affected thereby.

Section V: Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed under and in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Section VI: Assignment

This Agreement and the rights and obligations hereunder may not be transferred, pledged, encumbered, assigned, anticipated or alienated by either party.

Section VII: Hold Harmless and Assumption of Risk

Rowan County Arts agrees that the City shall not be responsible for damages to property or injuries to persons, which may arise from or be incident to the services provided by this Agreement and Rowan County Arts shall hold the City and its individual members, board of council, and employees harmless from any and all claims for such damages or injuries. Further, Rowan County Arts agrees that at all times during which this Agreement is effective, it will maintain a public liability insurance policy in an amount satisfactory to the City insuring against damages or injuries referenced herein.

Section VIII: Termination

Either party may terminate this Agreement by giving at least a six (6) month notice to the other party of its intention to terminate this Agreement. Said notice must include a copy of the resolution either from the Board of City Council or the Board of Directors of Rowan County Arts.

Section IX: Notice

All notices between the parties relating to this Agreement shall be in writing, effective when delivered, or, if mailed, effective on the second day following mailing, postage prepaid, to the address for the party stated below or to such address as either party may specify by notice to the other:

A waiver by either party or any breach of any term or provision in this Agreement shall not be construed as a waiver of any succeeding breach of the same or any other term or provision.
