Dixie Heights High School-FBLA Regional Officer Camp

Supervision will be provided by staff at a ratio of 1:1. Transportation is parent responsibility. Lodging and meals are at the 4-H Camp. Cost per student is \$110. Funds have been secured for indigent students.

Simon Kenton High School- Boys Soccer

Simon Kenton requests permission for 18 students to travel to Masterson Park in Lexington, KY July 27-28, 2018 for the Bluegrass State Games. Supervision will be provided by staff at a ratio of 1:4.5. Transportation is via District bus, driving back and forth both days. Meals will be student packed. There is no cost per student.

Simon Kenton High School- Girls Soccer

Simon Kenton requests permission for 22 students to travel to Lexington, KY July 27-28, 2018 for the Bluegrass State Games. Supervision will be provided by staff at a ratio of 1:7. Transportation is via District bus, driving back and forth both days. Meals will be student packed. There is no cost per student.

Scott High School- Boys Soccer

Scott requests permission for 23 students to travel to Masterson Park in Lexington, KY July 27-29, 2018 for the Bluegrass State Games. Supervision will be provided by staff at a ratio of 1:4. Transportation is via District bus. Meals will be student packed or with parents. Lodging will be in the Hampton Inn, Frankfort, KY. There is no cost per student.

Scott High School- Volleyball

Scott requests permission for 12 students to travel to Dunbar and Tates Creek High Schools in Lexington, KY August 3-5, 2018 for the Bluegrass State Games. Supervision will be provided by staff at a ratio of 1:2. Transportation is parent responsibility. Meals will be student packed, and at the Olive Garden and Chick Fil A near the schools. Lodging will be in the Lexington Mariott Green. Cost per student is \$20. Funds have been secured for indigent students.
