## Floyd County Board Of Education Issue Paper

Date: 7/6/2018

Action/Discussion Item: A new PE/Health Position at Betsy Layne Elementary-Budgetary changes have allowed for the posting of a vacancy for a new PE/Health teaching position for the 2018-2019 school year at BLES. (See *Rationale* below).

Applicable Statutes or Regulation: Bd. Policies 05.3 & 05.3 AP.1; 05.31 AP.21; 05.33

<u>Issue:</u> To approve a new PE/Health teaching position at Betsy Layne Elementary.

<u>Background:</u> Physical Education and Health are required and necessary when teaching the whole child. Therefore, it's vital that BLES maintain this commitment to educating our students in these areas.

<u>Budget/Financial Issues:</u> Budgetary changes because of the school's Title 2A allocation has allowed for this new position.

<u>Alternative:</u> To not approve a new PE/Health teaching position at Betsy Layne Elementary.

Recommended Action: To approve a new PE/Health teaching position at Betsy Layne Elementary.

Rationale: The BLES School-Based Decision Making Council (SBDM) recently received the school's allocation of funds for the Federal. Title 2A grant for Classroom Reduction. We've are using these funds to re-classify a point-7 of the salary of an elementary position from Section 4 to Title 2A. This budgetary change has now allowed for the posting of a vacancy for a PE/Health teaching position for the 2018-2019 school year.
