Action/Discussion Item: SCHOOL-WIDE FUNDRAISER-Scholastic Book Fairs: BLES students and staff are requesting the approval of a school-wide fundraiser for Scholastic Book Fairs, one sales event in the fall and one sales event in the spring semesters for the 2018-2019 school year. These sales events will take place in the school's library on school grounds, during school hours. The funds raised from these events will go into the school's general fund and will be spent on student reading/literacy events/activities.

<u>Issue:</u> To approve a school-wide fundraiser for Scholastic Book Fairs at Betsy Layne Elementary School.

Background: Each year, BLES administration and staff use the funds raised from the Scholastic Book Fairs to supplement student AR program/awards, such as fieldtrips, trophies, ribbons, etc. The Book Fairs also promote parent involvement with our Family Resource Center collaborating with our library personnel to have "Donuts for Dads" and "Muffins for Moms" events.

<u>Budget/Financial Issues:</u> The school does not spend any funds to sponsor a Scholastic Book Fair sales event at our school.

Alternative: To not approve the request for a school-wide fundraiser sales events.

Recommended Action: To approve the request for a school-wide fundraiser for BLES.
