Action/Discussion Item: SCHOOL-WIDE FUNDRAISER- *KONA ICE SALES*: BLES students and staff are requesting the approval of a school-wide fundraiser for KONA ICE sales on school grounds, during school hours for multiple times each month for the 2018-2019 school year. The funds raised from these events will go into the school's general fund and spent on student events, such as student rewards, PBIS system, fieldtrips, and/or operational expenses, etc.

Applicable Statutes or Regulation: Bd. Policies 05.3 & 05.3 AP.1; 05.31 AP.21; 05.33

Issue: To approve a school-wide fundraiser for Betsy Layne Elementary School.

Background: Each year, BLES administration and staff offer various events/experiences for their kids/students. These events/experiences might include reward ceremonies, fieldtrips, monthly Super Bobcat Challenge (PBIS system), admissions to parks/events, class and student rewards, and other experiences that require funds to pay for expenses associated with these events. KONA ICE slushy sales have been successful in the past, and the students would benefit from future sales.

Budget/Financial Issues: The school does not spend any funds to sponsor a KONA ICE event at the school.

Alternative: To not approve the request for a school-wide fundraiser events.


Recommended Action: To approve the request for a school-wide fundraiser for BLES.
