Amber Minor, Finance Officer, gave the financial report for May 2018. The ending general fund cash balance was \$5.42 million as opposed to \$5.62 million at the end of May 2017. Revenue was down 1% compared to the year before. Revenue increased \$1.53 million from April to May, largely due to receiving \$245,480 in Property & Motor Vehicle Taxes, \$116,454 in Utility Taxes, \$869,032 in SEEK Funds, and completing the capital funds transfer of \$232.623. General Fund has received 95% of the revenue that was budgeted for this fiscal year. Expenditures were up 4% compared to last year at this time. Expenses have increased \$1.79 million from April to May (typical increase per month is \$1.4 - \$1.5 million), largely due to spending \$1.15 million in Instruction and \$192,071 in Building Operations. General Fund has expended or encumbered 80.5% of the expenses that were budgeted for this fiscal year. General fund has expended or encumbered 76.5% of the revenue for this current fiscal year including the beginning balance. The auditor was in the district last week and has started work. Multiple summer payrolls are almost completed. Finalization of general fund spending will be complete by June 29th. We are working on closing the year currently. In July we will open the new year and start new PO's. The unaudited annual financial report is due to KDE. We will be busy setting up new employees. We should also receive our tax assessment information from KDE in July. In August we will need to set tax rates in regards to the information received from the tax assessment. We will also look at potential adjustments to Section 6 allocations, and last but not least students and staff return in August.

# Superintendents Report June 21, 2018

- Pension update Franklin Circuit Judge Shepard determined that SB 151 was ruled unconstitutional. The judge went on to say that the General Assembly violated the Kentucky Constitution when it passed a surprise bill with only six hours after introducing the legislation. We do expect the governor to appeal the ruling.
- Our principals and directors have been working hard to fill our open positions around the district. The principals have hired much earlier this year, which has increased our applicant pool and quality of the applicant pool. We have a very few amount of positions still left open.
- All our staff including certified and classified participated in a safety update training from Dan Orman from the Kentucky Center for Safe Schools, which focused on Situational Awareness and other safety topics. The staff also received information on child abuse and neglect from social workers from DCBS.
- Esther Hayslett and I met with Harrodsburg Police Chief Allen and Commissioner Scott Mosely to discuss SRO's (School Resource Officer) for the schools for next year. We are going to add two more SRO's next year. One SRO will be placed at MCSHS, One SRO will be placed at KMS, and one SRO to share at MCES, MCIS, and the Harrodsburg ATC.
