Subject: CAEP Site Visitor Training

Good afternoon

We are counting the days down here at CAEP for our National Site Visitor Training that is scheduled for July 16-19 in Kansas City. You should have already received an official invitation from CAEP and hopefully you have returned the RSVP. I do have a couple of announcements for you as a P12 educator in coming to the conference.

- 1. Monday evening July 16 starting at 6 pm NEA will be hosting a dinner and welcome dinner at the conference hotel. So you should make plans to arrive by 5 pm to check in and attend this dinner. Blake West, our NEA liaison will be hosting the dinner.
- 2. Tuesday morning July 17 8:30 12 we will be hosting an Orientation session for P12 educators about higher education accreditation. Last year we got feedback from the P12 attendees at the training that the language in the training was overwhelming to those of you coming from P12. In fact my wife, a high school math teacher confirmed this to me. So the morning session will be for P12 teachers only.
- 3. Tuesday 1 pm the National Site visitor training starts where you will be joined by about 70 other trainees and 20-30 new leads for the site visits. The training concludes on Thursday at 2 pm.
- 4. Prior to purchasing your ticket through our travel agency we need you to do two things:
 - a. Review the Materials in the Canvas Learning Management System (LMS) and take the two quizzes. The first quiz has already been completed by a number of you and the second quiz will be available tomorrow, Friday June 15.
 - b. Permission from your building principal or district administrator. Last summer we trained a number of P12 teachers and then when we assigned them to site teams their building principal or district administrator wouldn't approve their leave. NEA reimburses your district for the substitute salary so it doesn't cost your district anything, nor does it cost you. So if you can gain permission to attend one site visit probably next spring. Site visits usually start on Sunday and end on a Tuesday. This will help immensely so that CAEP doesn't pay for travel expenses to train you and then you not be able to attend a site visit. Once you get this letter or email you can upload to Canvas in the folder labeled "P12 Letter of approval".
 - c. Once you have done both of these tasks then you will receive travel documents about the airfare. You should complete these by June 22 so that you can meet the deadlines below.

Here are the Important Deadlines:

June 22 - Opening day for booking travel via CAEP's travel agency Gant.

July 1 – Last day to finalize travel reservations
