Action/Discussion Item: South Floyd Elementary School Honor Club Trip for Middle Grades

Applicable Statutes or Regulation: Board policy 09.3(Student activities of an educational nature shall be encouraged and maintained, based upon the needs and interests of pupils.) Board policy 09.36 (Field trips shall be related to the course of study and have educational value.)

CSIP Activity #6 B2, B3 Varied classroom instruction to address diversity and enhance student learning. (Students will be exposed to theatrical productions, various types of arts/music and high level learning experiences through field trips, presentations by local and professional presenters, in-house presentations, and virtual tours.)

Issue: Approval of South Floyd Middle School Honor Club Trip

Background: South Floyd Elementary School is requesting an incentive trip for students in grades 6-8 that demonstrate values and requirements of being an honor student. Honor students are those that demonstrate high academic success with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 for the entirety of the year, dedication to their studies with no discipline referrals, and remain in coordination with the Floyd County Schools attendance policy. It is our goal to travel to New York City, NY via charter bus to tour the historical monuments and buildings the city has to offer such as the Statue of Liberty, Empire State Building, Ellis Island, 9/11 Memorial and Museum, and much more. In order to maximize instruction, this trip is scheduled during our spring break on April 4th - April 7th. Thus, the group will be touring these educational sites during the non-instructional school days. The students and sponsors will do fundraisers throughout the year to cover the cost of the trip. Our hope is that the students learn the value of money and budgeting while working towards their desired amounts. It is my goal as Honor's Club Sponsor to expose the students of South Floyd Elementary to educational opportunities first hand through travel. It is my intent to have a student: adult ratio of 5:1 to ensure supervision is satisfactory and sufficient. The Honor's Club maintains a financial account through the school where all
