Dear Parent/Guardian:

On the reverse side of this letter is the Pupil-Parent Information Form for the Jefferson County Public School (JCPS) District. The purpose of the information requested is to assist the district in obtaining federal funding for students who live on federal property. These properties include **Beecher Terrace, Parkway Place, Scattered Sites – Mgr. 40, Dosker Manor, St. Catherine Ct., Avenue Plaza, Scattered Sites I, Lourdes Hall, Oaks, Scattered Sites-Hope VI, Amp 53 Units, Newburg, W. E. Seay Plaza, Scattered Sites V, Clarksdale II-Friary, Berrytown Apts., Clarksdale I-Scattered 69, 50 Apartments, Sheppard Square and St. Martin Apts.** Also, any student whose parents/guardians are employed by the federal government or a foreign government will need to fill out this form. This includes any parents/guardians who are on **ACTIVE** military duty.

The federal government is not required to pay local property taxes on property it owns. Recognizing this loss of tax revenue, Public Law 103-382 authorizes payments to school districts to compensate them for the students who are federally connected. All monies received from the federal government as a result of this survey are used for current operating expenses and to benefit all students in the district.

If you reside on any of the above properties or are employed by the federal/foreign government (which includes the **ACTIVE** military), please complete and return this form to your child's homeroom teacher by **Friday, November 9, 2018**; otherwise, please disregard it. List each child in the family/household who attends a JCPS District school, but do not list a Head Start student. We already have received federal funds for Head Start students. An individual form must be completed for each student and returned to the child's homeroom teacher
